

What is DTFs?

- ▶ History of their establishment as of 2005
 - ▶ MoU between UNIFEM (UN Women), National Committee on Family and Women
 - ▶ Training
 - ▶ Re-orientation for social protection issues
 - ▶ The Government activities aimed at sustainability of the DTFs (1-st stage–Sughd oblast; 2-nd stage – Khatlon oblast and 8 DRDs;
 - ▶ Database, joint activities with Ombudsman Office

Some statistics

- ▶ Only in 2011 more than 12 000 people received legal advice and consultation in existing DTFs in the whole Republic (more than 80% of them are women);
 - ▶ During the first quarter of 2012, 5 572 people were served and 4 809 of them are women.




What is next?
